A message from Ronnie Hazzard

Happy New Year from your building committee! While we continue to wait on the Lord to bring that perfect buyer our way to purchase our current campus property, there is plenty going on at our "new campus".

The Salvation Army began using part of the first floor to collect toys and other items for their annual Christmas Angel Tree project. Approximately 2,000 children received toys and other gifts through this program. Our facility was also used as the distribution point for this project. They will continue to use our building for a few more months as a warehouse for household items going to Hurricane Harvey victims.

Another ministry opportunity we will be involved in is 8 Days of Hope in March. Our building will be used to house volunteers as they help Harvey victims rebuild. Trailers for restroom and shower facilities will be in the parking lot and our building will be used as the "bunkhouse". **We will need to have a couple of work days to prepare for this event. Be watching and listening for more details of when you can help us!**

Building Updates: We are in the midst of obtaining a second estimate to have the cross hung on the outside of the building. Funds have been donated to complete this project, so once we have finished receiving estimates, we will install our newly built cross on the east side of the building. Also, Hurricane Harvey "helped" us find several roof leaks. The roof is still under warranty, so the roofing company has already been out to make the needed repairs. Finally, we have secured the services of a commercial realtor to assist in selling our current property and buildings. There have been several inquiries, so please continue to make this a matter of prayer.

Thank you for your encouraging words, positive attitude, and patience as we journey together through this process.

YEAR-END GIVING STATEMENTS

As you begin preparing your taxes, you may need to access your Year-End Giving Statement through your Simple Church Member Management Account at <https://fbctc.simplechurchcrm.com> or you may use the app.

After you have logged in, type in your name then click on "giving". Then click on the down arrow next to the gear icon. Click on "filter". For the start date, enter January 1, 2017. For the end date, enter December 31, 2017. Then click on "submit". Your statement will open in another window for you to print. (If not, click on gear icon again and select print.) If you are married, you may need to print one for each name most likely.

If this is your first time to log in to your Simple Church Member Management Account, you can do so by clicking on forgot password and then typing in the e-mail address that the church has on file for you. Then your login name and password will be e-mailed to you.

If you need your statement mailed to you, you may make a special request through the church office.

MELINDA WEBB MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

First Baptist Church of Texas accepted a generous endowment from Mr. Frank Webb to establish "The Melinda Webb Memorial Scholarship". Melinda was born deaf, but was highly intelligent and learned to talk. She was the first child to be mainstreamed in the second grade at Roosevelt-Wilson Elementary School. Though Melinda was only ten when she died, she touched many lives. She, along with her parents, attended our church in 1947.

This renewable scholarship in Melinda's memory is provided each year to two graduating female students from Texas City High School who have participated in extracurricular activities and have a grade point average of at least 3.0. On November 24, 2008, Frank Webb died at the age of 91. His memory and Melinda's will continue to live through this scholarship.
