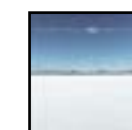

### Youth Camp

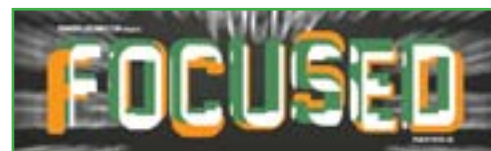

#### MELINDA WEBB MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

First Baptist Church of Texas accepted a generous endowment from Mr. Frank Webb to establish “The Melinda Webb Memorial Scholarship”. Melinda was born deaf, but was highly intelligent and learned to talk. She was the first child to be mainstreamed in the second grade at Roosevelt-Wilson Elementary School. Though Melinda was only ten when she died, she touched many lives. She, along with her parents, attended our church in 1947.

This renewable scholarship in Melinda's memory is provided each year to two graduating female students from Texas City High School who have participated in extracurricular activities and have a grade point average of at least 3.0. On November 24, 2008, Frank Webb died at the age of 91. His memory and Melinda's will continue to live through this scholarship.
