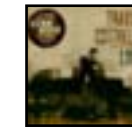

A message from Meschel Hara

Time. Our time is very valuable. I think we all wish we had more of it or wish we could pause it. But unfortunately, time just keeps on progressing and seems to move faster and faster with every day.

When I think back on my relationship with my dad, my fondest memories are of times when we were just spending time together: Bike rides, playing board games, card games, fishing, eating, and the list goes on.

I remember first hearing the thought of being intentional with our time at a Children's Ministry conference and have never forgot it. Life is so busy and so full of things to do that we have to be intentional with the time that we have and what we choose to fill our days with.

Let's make the most of our time by spending it with those we love and making sure that we are present and intentional with that time. In our world of top-edge technology, we have to fight the draws of technology for our time and intentionally put digital devices aside for real face-to-face, one-on-one time.

It's also important for us to make time for our Heavenly Father so that relationship grows as well. God's Word tells us that we are to love Him first and put Him first. We have to be intentional with finding time to spend with God and that's not always easy, especially with the busyness of our culture. Sundays are an "easy" day to spend time with God because the time is already carved out through our church services. But as a mom of only two children, I know that it's definitely not "easy" to get up early on Sunday and get your family ready for church. That's where being intentional comes into play.

When looking for ways to spend time with God throughout the week, I would encourage you to find some type of devotional book or a One Year Bible.
