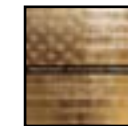

### Real Men & Women Sing Real Loud!

Corporate Worship can be broken down into three important aspects: Honor, Response & Encouragement.

We gather, as a body of Believers, to Honor God. The main purpose and priority of our gathering is **for Him!** We sing songs about and to Him, we pray to Him and we honor Him through the reading and teaching of His Word. We proclaim that He is our priority!

As we worship God, we have the opportunity to Respond to His presence in our lives as well as what we learn while being in a time of corporate worship. Response is the willingness and action of allowing Him to change us. Two classic examples of an encounter with God and response to Him is Isaiah in Isaiah 6 and the Woman At The Well in John 4. They experienced God in different ways but then they responded with "Here am I, send me" and telling the entire town that Jesus is here!

Encourage – when we gather with other Believers for worship, we can't help but be encouraged, and we have the opportunity to encourage others... the stories we tell, the burdens we bear and the singing we engage in! Ephesians 5:19 says to "address one another in psalms, hymns and spiritual songs..."
