A Message from Robert Miller

MAKING ADJUSTMENTS

I watched the Super Bowl between the New England Patriots and the Los Angeles Rams. It was a surprising game in this era of NFL football when the rules have been made to favor the offenses and to have high scoring games. However, the defenses were ruling the day at this Super Bowl. Both defenses were so well prepared that they recognized every play and were shutting down each other's offense. The game was tied 3 to 3 in the fourth quarter, and neither offense had been able to move the ball. But in the 4th guarter, the offensive coordinator for the Patriots drew up a play that his team had never run before. It caught the Rams off guard. They ran that same play three consecutive times and scored a touchdown. It was the difference in the game. The Patriots adjusted while the Rams did not.

I was thinking about that when it comes to life. I have always been a planner and believed in long-range planning for my life as well as for the churches I have served. I plan out on paper how it ought to go. Problem is life happens, and I have to make adjustments to my plans. I believe in being prepared, and planning, but the ability to adjust is just as important if not more so than making plans. We don't plan for sickness, death, unexpected expenses, etc. Our church has undoubtedly had to adjust in the past few years in our move to the mall. The Southern Baptist Convention in light of the Houston Chronicles comprehensive report on how poorly our Convention and churches have handled sexual abuse of minors in our churches need to make some radical adjustments.

It is significant for us to make adjustments. However, our adjustments need to be made after much prayer, listening to the wisdom of the Scriptures, and learning from those who are experienced in handling those areas. In 1985, a staff member of a church I was serving at the time was accused of inappropriately touching a couple of our youth at camp. I did what I thought was best at the time. I called the kid's parents, brought the staff member before the deacons, and requested that he resign. Afterward, I didn't feel good about how it was handled. I sought out counsel from a policeman, an assistant district attorney, and a counselor who specialized in sex offenders. After that experience, I made sure extensive background checks were done on any future staff members I was in charge of hiring. Also, I determined that if it ever happened again, my first call would be to the police. Thank God, I have never had an accusation of sexual abuse of a minor made in any of the churches I have served since that time.

Plan, prepare and work your plan, but be willing to make adjustments. God will give you the wisdom, strength, and flexibility if you stay close to Him.
