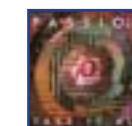

A Message from Robert Miller

Holy Land

Next Tuesday I will be going to Israel for the third time in two and a half years. It truly is a trip of a lifetime. This trip will be my second time leading a group from here.

During my seminary days, my Greek professor told us that being able to read from the original languages of the Bible would be like watching a color TV versus black and white. He was right because learning the original languages opened up some new insights for me. But if learning Greek and Hebrew was like watching color TV, then going to the Holy Land is like watching a movie. Ever since going to the Holy Land when reading the Bible, I see it in my mind. When I read about Gideon selecting the soldiers by whether they cupped their hands or lapped like a dog from the stream, I have been to that stream, and I have seen the nearby hill where the Midianite army would have been looking on. When the Bible talks about Samson burning the Philistine vineyards by tying torches to fox tails, I have seen where that would have taken place. When the Bible tells about Megiddo and the battle to come, I have looked over that valley. I was on the mountain where Elijah confronted the prophets of Baal. I have been to the valley where David defeated Goliath. I have stood on the hillside where Jesus gave the sermon on the mount. I have taken a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee where Jesus walked on water. I have been to the house where Jesus healed Peter's mother-in-law. I have walked the Via Dolorosa where Jesus carried his cross to Golgotha. I have seen the places where Jesus was conceived, born, died, and resurrected. I visited the house in Joppa, where Peter had his vision and opened up the gospel to the gentiles. And this is only a portion of the places I have visited.

In the next few weeks, I will be praying about whether to lead another trip to the Holy Land. I have to schedule it out about 18 months out to get the guide I prefer. A lot of whether I schedule another trip will depend on the interest I receive. I need at least 26 people to make a trip. If you are interested, please let me know in the next few weeks. We always have family, friends, and folks from our area that go with our church members, and all are welcome!
