A Message from Ronnie Hazzard

With all the relief, excitement, and thanks to God for answered prayer that last week's closing on the Mainland property brought, it's now time for your building committee to roll up their sleeves and get back to work! On behalf of the committee, thank you for your encouragement, patience, and prayers as we have waited on God's perfect timing for this sale to take place. I would be remiss to not include a HUGE thank you to Sheri Williams for all the work she has done to make this sale a reality. She, along with attorney Amanda Johnson and Sharon Rose from Roberts, Johnson, and Cain have put many hours into the behind-the-scenes work associated with this sale.

With that behind us and a couple of dollars now in a separate checking account to be used for the building project only, I wanted to give you a feel for what's happened in recent weeks, what's going on now, and what the future looks like.

First, in the past two weeks or so, we have received our engineer-stamped Mechanical, Electrical, and Plumbing drawings (MEPs) from the architect. Two major events are happening with those drawings: 1) One set of those drawings has been given to our general contractor, Mike Bricker & Associates, to work on a cost estimate of the buildout. We should have that cost estimate in the next few weeks. Please add Mike Bricker and Associates to your prayer list for guidance, wisdom, and safety for all who will work on our property. 2) Another set of those drawings have been submitted to the City of Texas City for approval and the building permit required to begin work.

Second, the committee is now meeting weekly to dig into the details of what the buildout will look like. That means looking at options and making decisions on wall colors, types of doors, flooring (no, much to my dismay, there won't be any burnt orange carpet!), and many other details that we probably don't even know about yet!

Third, you should know that we expect the cost estimate to be much higher than what we received from the Mainland property sale, but we will bridge the gap with possibly a capital campaign and additional borrowing. Obviously, none of that will happen without you, the Church, understanding all the details and approving. Should anyone want more details of the financials for the buildout, please don't hesitate to seek out one of the building committee members.

Lastly, the most popular question thus far is: Once started, when will we be in our "new digs"? While we will have a much better idea once construction has begun, our contractor is telling us he expects the buildout, once started, to take around 9 months.

This is an exciting time in the life of FBCTC! There is a lot of work ahead, but we know that the Lord has great things planned for us. To me, it's already evidenced by the new faces I see every Sunday, as well as the excitement I see and hear from many of you. I hope you'll join me in praying daily for every aspect of this project, because we all know that:
