Music

It's a personal thing. We all have likes and dislikes when it comes to music. Your background, culture, heritage and education may or may not influence your personal choices. I've known some very educated people loving the simplest musical styles and some with less education loving symphonies. Maybe that's why some of the "musical instruction" we see in the Bible covers all kinds... Psalms, Hymns AND Spiritual Songs. And, our guidebook deals more with HOW and to WHO we sing and play than WHAT we sing and play...

Recently we requested prayer for a good friend of ours in the hospital. Our strong and long friendship has a lot to do with shared musical experiences. We texted back and forth about trusting God, the strength we have in Him, etc. What struck a "chord" (pun not originally intended, but too good to pass up...) were the song titles, YouTube videos and lyrics we shared that have brought peace, trust and encouragement in the past and again recently. While it was great visiting the past and the emotions that the songs brought, not once did I think that we should sing those songs here and now. They ministered to me in a personal way. They wouldn't mean the same to our church now.

She explained that when she saw it in the worship guide/newsletter the weekend prior she looked it up online and listened several times before that service!
