## A Message from Robert Miller

The Reason We Have Church!

Last week former US President Barack Obama offered some advice to young people hoping to change society by taking part in "cancel culture." If you are not familiar with this, a lot of the Millennials are harshly criticizing and condemning folks that they disagree. If someone does one thing or says something that they consider wrong, then that person is ostracized, and anything they have ever said or done is deemed to be wrong. Former President Obama said, "This idea of purity and you're never compromised and you're always politically woke and all that stuff, you should get over that quickly... The world is messy. There are ambiguities. People who do really good stuff have flaws." I agree wholeheartedly with our former president. It amazes me that so many young people think they are working for social justice by being hyper-critical and judgmental on social media. They are not!

I have not only seen this attitude on twitter among young people, but I have experienced this attitude in most of the churches I have served over the past 44 years. Judgmental ism, being hyper-critical, holier than thou, and having a condemning spirit have been around for a long time. Unfortunately, there are always people who applaud this kind of legalistic attitude. Jesus did not! "Do not judge, or you too will be judged." (Matthew 7:1) Jesus' teachings and example runs counter to this Pharisaical tendency in all of

I pray that our Church will guard against this sin of the Pharisees and be a Church that welcomes sinners. Remember Jesus' words in Mark 2:17, "It is not the healthy who need a doctor, but the sick. I have not come to call the righteous but sinners." That is a good thing to keep in mind for our Church. We are here for sinners, not saints! Let us seek to have a church where people can come and find Jesus in a shame-free environment. I am convinced that when we lift Jesus up that He will draw them in and change them without our being judgmental and discounting people because they have sinned.
