

A Message from John Talley

Bill Gaither Music Sunday!

No one has single-handedly impacted worship music over several generations the way Bill Gaither has. Some may have written more songs, others may have recorded as many, but few, if any, have reinvented themselves in different ways to stay effective with their musical craft and reaching people with the gospel through music. His songs have been recorded by...The Statler Brothers, David Crowder Band, Sandi Patty, The Cathedrals, Elvis and many others!

Highlights:

Began singing with the "Bill Gaither Trio" in the 1950's

Recorded his break-through song, He Touched Me, in 1964

The "Gaither Vocal Band" was formed spontaneously backstage at a "Bill Gaither Trio" Concert in the early 1980's

The Gaither Homecoming Videos and Tours started in 1991 after another spontaneous gathering of musicians followed a "Gaither Vocal Band" homecoming recording session

Has received numerous Grammy and Dove awards

Bill and Gloria Gaither have written over 700 Southern Gospel and Contemporary Christian songs

"Our calling is not just making music... but communicating the reality of Christ. If we have done anything right over the years, I hope we have built bridges where people could connect with God and with each other. That is what started us writing and what will keep us going for the rest of our lives." Bill Gaither

I met Bill Gaither at a Houston church choir conference in the 90's when many local worship pastors were asked to sing in the conference choir. Around that time, we moved to Katy to serve at Kingsland Baptist Church. Thanks to also meeting Geron Davis (author of *Holy Ground*) at this yearly conference, our choir got to sing with some of the homecoming singers in a premier of Gaither songs arranged for choir. These associations also led us to sing with the Gaither Homecoming Christmas Tour at the Toyota Center in the early 2000's.

While at Kingsland, a bass in the choir, James Payne, approached one of our soloists, Jeff Skaggs, about forming a quartet. Jeff suggested he ask me to be in the group (because I had keys to the church!) and Steve Whitcomb because he was a true tenor. We began rehearsing and performing often. Every song we sang was from the "Gaither Vocal Band" and when we needed a name Kingsland Vocal Band was too easy, but it stuck. We recently reunited to sing in James' daughter's wedding (this next weekend)! While rehearsing we jumped on the opportunity for a "reunion tour" that included San Antonio and now Texas City! I'm thankful for my "homecoming friends" helping us worship with Gaither music and being at FBCTC this Sunday!
