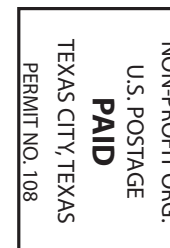

A Message from Dennis Johns

Oh Be Careful Little Eyes What You See

Do you remember a little song we used to sing in preschool days; "Oh be careful little eyes what you see, oh be careful little eyes what you see, for the Father up above is looking down in love, oh be careful little eyes what you see?" This is one of those songs that has such simple lyrics but hits a home run on meaning. Other verses follow;

"Oh be careful little ears what you hear,

Oh be careful little tongue what you say,

Oh be careful little hands what you do,

Oh be careful little feet where you go,

Oh be careful little heart who you trust."

The first verse sets the tone for the ones that follow. When this song was written I'm not sure if anyone would have dreamed that our eyes could take in so much in a day. It is amazing to think of what technology has delivered in the way of knowledge and being connected, but equally amazing is the tendency to get lost in a world of isolation and consumption. Please be careful little ears to hear that I am not trying to go ballistic on technology, but merely attempting to bring awareness to balance.

What we have allowed into our lives through the eyes of our daily routine could have a tendency to erode our Christian values. How much time has been lost surfing or snooping on social media or what relationship have we neglected because of following a thread to its never-ending conclusion? The list could go on.

This shift did not happen overnight; this acquired, habitual disposition has not been intentionally developed, but has been allowed to germinate over a period of time. It has been perpetuated by a consistent process of being connected and as a result we find ourselves further away from God's intended outcome.

Make time today to evaluate what your little eyes are seeing; Are you seeing God at work in your life and lives around you? Make time today to evaluate what your ears are hearing...what your tongue is saying... what your hands are doing...where your feet are going...who your heart is trusting for the "Father up above is looking down in love" and he desires fellowship and companionship with you.

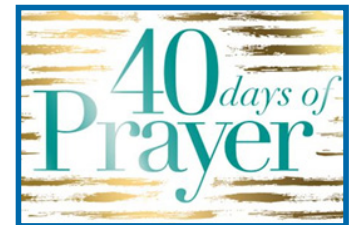
SANTA'S HELPERS
