Kids Church Jr. (Prek-3 - Kindergarten)

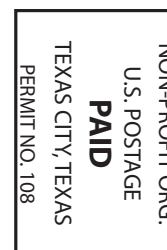
First Steps

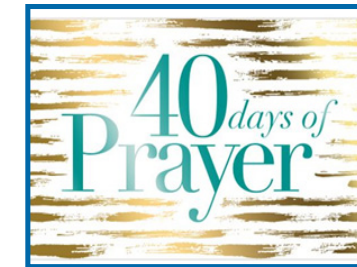
